First Light illuminates the city Fagle Tribute

he nonprofit group Groundwork Lawrence kicked off its First Light event Friday night at Essex Art Center in Lawrence with a silent auction and raffle.

Several local artists have designed lanterns from wood, iron and stained glass that function as an attractive ornament and a working lantern. The event will end on New Year's Eve with a
